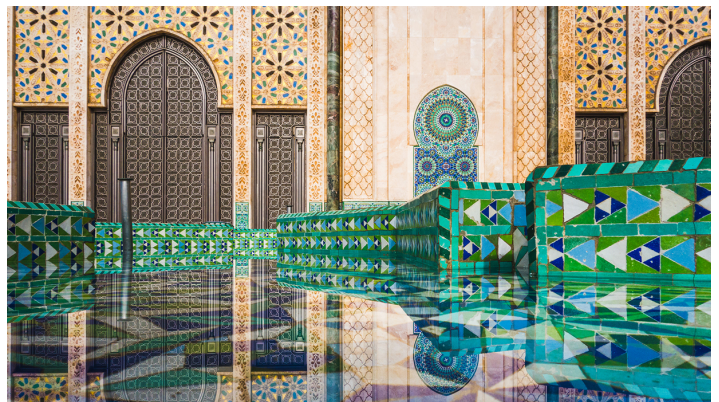

This ACTIVE program is designed for people who are in good health and can comfortably participate in a demanding daily schedule of physical activities. The itinerary may feature full days of ongoing activities. Excursions on this program require:

- walking distances of up to 3–5 miles
- walking on unpaved paths and/or uneven surfaces
- getting on/off motor coaches, boats and/or trains

Depending on the excursion, more leisurely alternatives may be available.

Day 1 | Depart gateway city

AHI FlexAir passengers depart for Casablanca, Morocco. Please check your luggage from your gateway city to your arrival city. Your claim checks should have the following airport code: CMN.

Day 2 | Casablanca, Morocco | Rabat

Sofitel Rabat Jardin des Roses

Arrive at Casablanca International Airport. Proceed through immigration and into the baggage claim area to retrieve your luggage. After completing customs, AHI FlexAir passengers traveling on flights that qualify for the group arrival transfer and Land Program passengers who have purchased seats on the group transfer should exit the baggage claim area and proceed to the designated meeting spot, where an AHI Travel representative will meet you. The meeting location will be provided with your final documents.

Transfer to Sofitel Rabat Jardin des Roses hotel in Rabat. Please note, if you arrive before check-in time, your room may not be immediately available.

Gather for a Welcome Reception and Dinner tonight. Meet the fellow travelers who will share in your upcoming Moroccan adventure!

Day 3 | Rabat

Sofitel Rabat Jardin des Roses

Savor a delicious breakfast at the hotel each morning of the program before embarking on the day's adventures.

Enrichment: Moroccan History. Learn about the country's fascinating history, from the Berber dynasty to modern-day Morocco.

Rabat Walking Tour. Head out to discover the many highlights of Rabat today! View the impressive façade and French-style landscaped gardens of the Royal Palace, the residence of Morocco's royalty. Continue to the Citadel of Chellah, which has been abandoned since the 1100s. For a thousand years before that, the enclave thrived as a port and city. Explore the grounds filled with Roman ruins, Islamic

artifacts, gardens of fig and orange trees and a magnificent doorway decorated with Arabic calligraphy. Next, witness two of Morocco's treasures located near the Bou Regreg River: the Mausoleum of Mohammad V and the Hassan Tower. Step inside the striking Mausoleum of Mohammad V, the resting place of past kings, to marvel at its opulent interior. Gaze in wonder at the impressive minaret of Hassan Tower, rising above the ruins of its mosque. Cap off your excursion at the Kasbah des Oudaïas, a picturesque and quiet neighborhood with whitewashed houses and soul-stirring views of the Atlantic Ocean and Sale, Rabat's sister city.

Lunch is included today at a local restaurant.

Free Time: Spend this afternoon exploring Rabat at your leisure, and make your own plans for dinner. Throughout the program, your Travel Director is available to provide suggestions for dining and sightseeing on your own.

Day 4 | Volubilis | Meknes | Fes

Volubilis & Meknes. Uncover the fascinating ruins of Volubilis, a remarkably preserved, UNESCO-listed Roman city. You'll see ruins from the third century B.C. to the 11th century A.D., including the Triumphal Arch, Basilica and ornate villas, many filled with beautifully detailed mosaics.

Continue to a local winery for a vineyard tour and a special tasting, followed by lunch.

Travel to Meknes, a UNESCO World Heritage-listed imperial city. See the beautifully preserved royal palace and the stunning Bab Mansour, a massive and intricately tiled gateway to the city. Walk through El Hedim Square, the city's main plaza, built in 1672.

Continue to Fes and check in to the Fes Marriott Hotel Jnan Palace. Settle in to your room, then join the group for dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Day 5 | Fes

Fes Marriott Hotel Jnan Palace

Fes. Explore this diverse city shaped by more than 12 centuries of history and tradition. Begin in Fes el-Bali, the ninth-century district within the medina, where narrow alleyways wind through lively souks, artisan workshops, spice stalls and the city's iconic tanneries. Admire the Nejjarine Fountain, carved from cedarwood and adorned with zellij tilework. See the Quaraouiyin Mosque, the world's oldest university, before entering the Al Attarine Madrasa, a historic 14th-century school for Islamic studies.

Savor a Moroccan lunch at a local restaurant, then continue to Fes Jdid, known as "New Fes," to explore the historic Mellah, the former Jewish district, and view the impressive Royal Palace. Cap off the day with breathtaking panoramic views across the entire medina.

Day 6 | Fes | Casablanca | Marrakech

Following an early breakfast, check out of the hotel and depart for Marrakech with a stop in cosmopolitan Casablanca.

Casablanca Discovery. Explore the modern city of Casablanca. Morocco's largest city is centuries old but looks modern, with its wide boulevards, public parks and white Art Deco architecture. Experience the vibe of city life in Casablanca's central piazza, Place Mohammad V. Surrounding the square are excellent examples of the city's unique Mauresque architecture. Among the beautiful structures to be seen include the Bank of Morocco, the Justice Palace, the French Consulate and the Post Building. Pause to admire the facade and stunning architecture of the Church of the Sacred Heart.

Enjoy lunch at Rick's Café, a re-creation of Rick's Café Américain, the timeless nightclub in the film "Casablanca."

Visit the Hassan II Mosque, one of the most spectacular religious buildings in Morocco with its 690-foot minaret and richly decorated interior. Nestled on a promontory on the edge of the city, the structure stands like a beacon against the horizon and the Atlantic Ocean.

Continue on to Marrakech and check in to Les Jardins de la Koutoubia.

Free Time: Settle in to your room and make your own plans for dinner. Spend the evening at leisure to enjoy Marrakech's many sights and sounds!

Day 7 | Marrakech

Enrichment: Moroccan Culture. Learn how Arab, European and African influences created Morocco's captivating culture.

Monuments of Marrakech. Nestled against a stunning backdrop of the snowcapped Atlas Mountains, the exotic city of Marrakech has long been a melting pot of cultures. Today, begin your exploration at the Ben Youssef Medersa. Originally built in the 14th century, later expanded in the 16th century, the Ben Youssef Medersa once served as the largest religious schools for Islamic studies in North Africa, accommodating some 900 students at a time. Explore its exquisitely decorated courtyard and prayer hall and see some of the 130 dormitory cells that once housed the students. Continue your discovery at the shaded souks, a lively, colorful marketplace located in the heart of the city's medina. Uncover local culture while wending through the maze-like markets, passing stalls selling textiles, clothing and handicrafts. Next, thrill to the sight of Palais Bahia, a not-to-be-missed landmark. Constructed in the 19th century by architect El Mekki for Si Moussa, chamberlain of Sultan Hassan I of Morocco, the palace boasts an array of luxurious apartments, courtyards, zellij mosaic floors and serene gardens.

After your walking tour, relax over a delicious lunch, followed by some time to rest and reflect.

Early this evening, head to the beautiful Koutoubia Mosque, easily recognized by its towering minaret. Built in the 12th century, the mosque is a blend of Moorish and Islamic architecture. Continue to Jemaa el-Fnaa, a gathering place for locals and tourists and a performance space for fire-eaters, acrobats, storytellers and musicians. Over the years, this expansive main square has become the beating heart of Marrakech, showcasing a spectrum of daily life. Watch the action from above at a rooftop café; then join your guide for a walk through the square. From food stalls serving up aromatic grilled meats to amusing street performers to the melodic flutes of snake charmers, experience a feast for the senses! Take a walk through the square with your guide before sitting down to an authentic Moroccan dinner.

Day 8 | Marrakech

Cooking & Calligraphy . Visit the Amal Targa Center, a nonprofit helping disadvantaged women develop cooking skills, gain roles in the hospitality industry and prepare for financial independence. Treat your palate to the flavors of Moroccan cuisine and learn about the country's storied food culture during an authentic cooking lesson. Learn how to prepare a selection of Moroccan recipes — such as salads, bread, tagine and dessert — using traditional ingredients.

While your lunch is cooking, enjoy a lesson on the intricate art of Arabic calligraphy. Recognized as an art worthy of special reverence, calligraphy is considered an artistic expression of the highest rank in the Islamic world. Discover the aesthetically appealing elements and elaborate methods of calligraphy, and try your hand at reproducing the beautiful patterns, lines and curves.

Free Time: Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure exploring beautiful Marrakech.

Day 9 | Atlas Mountains | Ourika Valley

Atlas Mountains. Encounter another side of Morocco during an excursion to the gorgeous Ourika Valley, part of the Atlas Mountains, which is North Africa's greatest mountain range. Begin the day with a stop at ANIMA Garden, where art and nature meet. Created by Austrian artist André Heller, the lush botanic gardens feature works by Picasso, Rodin and Haring, among others, while offering stunning views of the Atlas Mountains. Continue through the scenic Ourika Valley before delving into the fascinating Berber culture. Berbers, whose

civilization reaches back more than eight millennia, are the original inhabitants of these mountains. Their lives are closely intertwined with the land, and they make a living herding livestock and using age-old farming methods.

AHI Connects: Berber Home Visit. Meet a local Berber family in their home and learn about their fascinating cultural traditions and experience their warm hospitality.

Enjoy lunch beside the rushing Ourika River, surrounded by sweeping mountain vistas.

Free Time: Return to Marrakech for an evening at leisure.

Day 10 | Marrakech

Gardens & Souks. Discover Jardin Majorelle, an oasis of fountains, flora and vivid cobalt architecture created in the 1920s by French artist Jacques Majorelle and later restored by Yves Saint Laurent and his partner Pierre Bergé. Visit the Yves Saint Laurent Museum, featuring the designer's haute couture and a library. Return to the buzzing souks for a tour with tastings of local products and insights into the spices and herbs used in traditional meals.

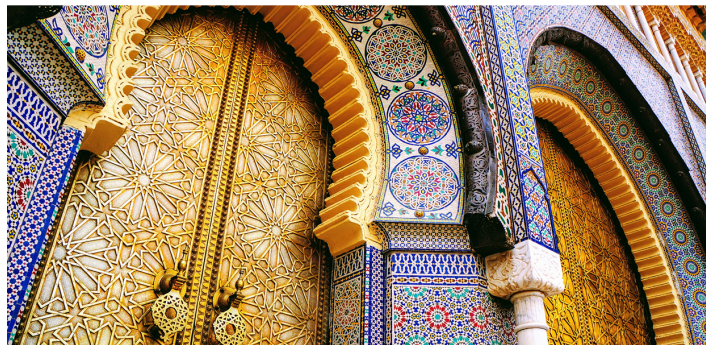
